Mr. S. D. Mande (Date of Birth – 10th Dec 1942), Aged 76 years is involved dedicatedly in Water & Environment sector for last more than 50 years. As early as in 1963-64 he worked during his academic age at Pune Cantonment Water Works, (2nd oldest WTP in India) Pune. Then joining to the erstwhile PHE Deptt. of Govt. of Maharashtra in July 1965, he handled no. of Water & Waste Water Schemes, till getting voluntary retirement as a Asstt. Superintending Engineer, World Bank Project Circle, Pune in March 1997. Major Schemes he was linked with, were Solapur Water Supply Scheme (with Ujjani Dam as a source) – Rs. 75 Crores, (106 km long M.S. & P. S. C. Rising & Gravity main., 80 MLD WTP etc. aided by OECF, Japan completed in 3_{1/2} years), Barshi-Kurduwadi Water Supply Scheme – Rs. 25 Crores (66 km long M.S. & P.S.C. Pipe Rising and Gravity Main, 27 MLD WTP), Akkalkot Emergency Water Supply Scheme – 30 km long pipe line, World Bank aided Rural Water Supply programme of Rs. 350 Crores etc.

After VRS from Govt. Service, he is now Proprietor of the firm "S. D. Mande & Associates, Consulting Engineers, Pune" completed 6 WTPs for L&T, Dehuroad Water Supply Scheme (first Cantonment Board in India having its own Water Supply Scheme), Sangamner Water Supply Scheme (Distt. Nagar) & no. of schemes in Aamby Valley City (Sahara India Group) etc.

He was Hon. Secretary of IWWA, Pune Centre for 25 years and Hon. Secretary General of IWWA, Mumbai for 4 years during which, he motivated the Association, got executed MoU between AWWA + IWWA, IWA + IWWA, PUB Singapore + IWWA. He has attended AWWA conventions in San Antonio (2006), Toronto (2007), Chicago (2010) & Boston (2014), Chicago (2016). 3 Singapore International Water Weeks, 5th "World Water Forum" in Istanbul (Turkey), 7th World Water Forum in (Daegu) South Korea & all 5 India Water Weeks and also visited International Water Association at 12, Caxton Street, London (UK). He is Hon. Secretary of "Upper Bhima Water Partnership" & "Reuse of City Effluents" for GWP-SASTAC.

He has been appointed as a member on Study Group for "Water Supply & Sanitation" on 10th Five year plan & 11th Five year plan of Maharashtra and presently working on the committee headed by Dr. S. V. Dahasahasra, for "Integrated Water Resources Management" of all urban area of Maharashtra for next 50 years for. His subject of concern is "Towards Blue Revolution – i.e. Poverty Alleviation Through Water Security".
